2006 New Hampshire View Tax

We, the taxpayers of New Hampshire, request that our elected officials do away with the "View Tax".

The View Tax is subjective, inconsistent and the State has no definition of what a view is. Furthermore, the view does not belong to the property owner and the owner has no control over said view.

We also request the NH Legislature, Senate and Governor to pass a law this year that requires state, municipal, and town Assessors in NH doing any type of property appraisal, including mass appraisals, to be licensed by the State of NH in order to hold them accountable.
